Details Regarding Application/Award

Eligibility:

- IRS Nonprofit (501(c)(3)) Organization
- Holding a program or event that promotes, preserves, and shares Korean cultural
- Demonstrated interest/tie to Korea/Korean culture

Award Details:

- With exception to extraordinary circumstances, grant awards shall not exceed two thousand dollars (\$2,000.00)
- Awards will be granted on a rolling basis
- Preferences will be granted to organizations/programs which have not received grant awards in the past calendar year

Selection Criteria:

- Recognized 501(c)(3) Organization by the IRS
- Detailed proposal regarding program/event
- Program/event promotes, preserves, or shares Korean culture
- Demonstrated interest/tie to Korea/Korean culture

Required Materials:

- Confirmation of 501(c)(3) status
- Detailed proposal regarding program/event
